

The God Who Hears: I AM who I AM Exodus 3:1-22

What are the most important truths you need to cling to when God has tasked you with something? What truths will not only get you through the task, but allow you to accomplish it His way and for His glory? Is who He is important? Is what He says about Himself of crucial value to you? Those made the difference for Moses. What difference do they make in your life?

1. Notice that after Moses turned aside to see the great sight of the burning bush, God saw that and began to interact with Him. Could it be possible that God is showing you something now, waiting for you to turn aside and see so that He can show you more? Have you ever turned away from a great sight and noticed that God did not continue to show you more?

2. Have you ever been given a task from God and asked the question 'Who am I, Lord?', when you should have considered more 'Who He is?' What is the danger in always asking who you are instead of asking first who He is?

3. What more do you need to know when you are facing struggles, trials, and hardships, than just knowing God says, 'I am with you.' Why do we tend to want to know more than that? What do our hearts say to God when we want to know more than what He is willing to tell us?

4. When you consider God's call to you, is that call endearing, affectionate and fatherly? Is it possible that you hear a condemning call or one that is forceful and abrasive? What is the difference to you? Why is it important to understand that our God is also our Father? Do you see God as affectionate only when you do something right or loving only because you have something to give, or do you see Him as loving first, before and without any merited deed on your part?

5. How does the holiness of God impact your desire for the Gospel? How is His holiness an integral and inseparable aspect of what we believers in Jesus try to apply every day?

6. Why is all that God does in your life for the purpose of worshipping Him? Does it astound you, when you consider all that He does and uses to bring worship to Himself? Do you see that as a worthy cause.....the worship of God? Are you willing to allow all aspects of your life to culminate in worship of Him? Are you truly content in that place?
