## College Park Church Twin Lakes Camp Scholarship Program

The goal of the scholarship program is to give every desiring child the chance to go to Twin Lakes Camp and to instill good basic Christian living principles.

2012 Guidelines:

- 1. Scholarships will be awarded only for Twin Lakes Camp and sent directly there. The camper must be registered for camp prior to receiving the scholarship. **College Park's week will be** June 11-16.
- 2. The camper must be a regular attendee of College Park Church.
- 3. Requirements must be completed and returned to Tammi Gant by May 31, 2012.
- 4. Church attendance includes Sunday school or worship services. Visitation to another church is acceptable, but please attach a dated bulletin from that church to the scholarship application. Attendance at College Park will be verified with our church attendance records. Attendance can be completed during any nine week period from February-May.
- 5. Church/Community service may include helping with a class, clean up, going to a nursing home or home of an elderly person to spend time with them, volunteering for a charity, assisting a mother of young children, yard work, etc. This is retroactive from Christmas 2011. Remember your school activities!
- 6. The theme this year is "Fully Loaded– Like a baked potato it is better with more toppings. God has called us to live **an enhanced life in our faith.**" The Bible memorization for this year will be taken from 2 Peter 1:3-15 using verses 5-8. You will be awarded five points per verse (no helps) plus five bonus points if all four verses are recited at one time with no more than two helps. You may memorize in KJV, NKJ, NASB, ESV or NIV.
