# WHO AM I?

## TACKLING MISTAKEN IDENTITIES

LIVE | 14

We all know the easy answers: adopted child of God; servant serving King Jesus; a new creation in Christ.

**But do our lives reflect it?** If someone were counting out the hours of your time, the secret thoughts and desires in your heart, would they agree with you or would they say something like:

*"Man obsessed with success at work."*

*"Mom desperate to homeschool her kids as close to perfection as possible."*

*"Woman consumed with outer signs of wealth and beauty."*

*"Man who lives for the pleasures money can buy."*

All true Christians have their sense of self ultimately grounded in the death, resurrection, and return of Jesus. But sin tempts us with mistaken identities, or alternative roles for us to live out. It offers us scripts: ways to think, to feel, and to act according to that false role. Because it can be subtle, we always need to be asking ourselves, "Am I living as a child of God, or am I living out a mistaken identity?"

Beginning Aug. 10, LIVE|14 will launch in its combination sermon series/small group format. For four weeks, we'll discuss how Christians are tempted to live out scripts based on an identity other than that found in Jesus Christ. We'll explore four major mistaken identities specifically, but use tools that can be applied to any false identity that tempts us. And we'll work together in groups to begin seeing those mistaken identities replaced with the Christian's true identity in Christ.

The LIVE content is designed for adults. However, we'll also have a track for youth to go through LIVE and a Family Devotional for children as well, so all ages can participate.

The book we're using as a resource this year is *Who Am I?: Identity in Christ* by Jerry Bridges. This short, profound book walks through eight aspects of our identity in Christ, explaining each and helping us understand how to live them out. As always, we want to throw down the gauntlet for a summer reading challenge: **pick up the book at the resource area** in the lobby and read it this summer, so you can begin thinking through identity-related issues! (Books cost \$6.)

GROWING CLASSES AT COLLEGE PARK

*Growing 100 is designed to equip you to use God's Word to help yourself and others grow in Christlikeness through the typical trials and struggles that we all face. Dawn Sites, who took Growing 100 last year, was able to put what she learned into practice in a number of ways. We interviewed Dawn to dig a bit deeper into why she took the class and how it was helpful to her.*

**What motivated you to take Growing 100?** My husband, Terry, and I had both been advocates for couples going through counseling at Twelve Stones and thought that the training would equip us to better help fellow Christians. We have found that it has helped us care for others in a number of different ways.

**In what ways did God use Growing 100 in your own life to help you grow spiritually?** The training was a weekly reminder of the power of the Word of God for answers to the questions that came up. It equipped me to use God's Word practically to care for my own soul and renew my mind. The format was logical and the multitude of scriptures with each topic helped to drive home the messages. The readings that I was able to do helped make applications more personal.

One specific example I remember related to a work scenario where I would have an underlying anxiety when I received emails from certain people. In the class, we were reminded that this kind of anxiety is sin against a holy God, but then we were given ways to combat that with the Word of God. I have found that praying and thinking on God's Word has really made a difference in my approach to work and receiving emails.

**Who do you think Growing 100 would be a good class for? Truly, this class would be good for every person at College Park Church.** This is an important opportunity to be trained to care for one another's souls. In our culture we have been lulled into thinking about life's problems in a way that is neither Biblical nor helpful for creating true heart change. As we have learned, we are all counselors, but the real question is whether we are Biblical in the counsel we provide.

**How did Growing 100 equip you to minister to others? Any examples?** After we had completed the first series of Growing classes, no less than eight different circumstances came up where we specifically utilized this training. One in particular was with a woman who shared with me that she was struggling with anxiety and depression. I asked if she would read a book with me that had been recommended in class, *Depression: Looking Up from the Stubborn Darkness* by Ed Welch. The two of us read together through a season of her deeper struggle. It was helpful and taught me much in the process.

We have also used the information on "fear vs faith" and have found that very useful. The information on guilt has also been very helpful. When someone says, "I just feel so guilty," now my thought is that there is a reason for this and it needs to be probed more deeply.

With the Great Commission, Jesus calls His followers to go to the world to share the Gospel to those who are lost. But while God is calling us to go to the world, He is also bringing the world to us.

International students from around the world pass through U.S. customs each year to pursue graduate and undergraduate degrees. Many come from countries where Christianity is limited or outlawed, and they come with stereotypes of Christianity. Sadly only 15-20 percent of the international students ever visit an American home during their time in the U.S., and few ever engage with a believer in Jesus Christ to learn and experience the truth of Christianity

The **College Park FISH** (Friends International Students Hospitality) program is an outreach ministry to connect Christian families with International students at the University of Indianapolis for the purpose of serving those that God is bringing to our community. The purpose of FISH is:

1. To be a friend who provides hospitality and encouragement to international students that are attending college in Indianapolis, in a new culture far from their home.
2. To help international students learn the American culture, English language, and expose them to an American home and Christian lifestyle.

3. To enable international students to see and experience the Light of Jesus through the atmosphere and activities of a Christian home, through the actions of a Christian family, and through spiritual discussions seasoned with love.

A testimony from an international student highlights the impact that two College Park women (Barbara and Diana—in picture above) had on her and her friend during their two years as college students in Indianapolis. Jenny writes to them after her graduation from the University of Indianapolis,

*"I begin to miss you two and hope you will have a good night!... I have so many words in my heart but don't know where to begin. I just want you to know, because of you two to become my American Family, my life in United States is more beautiful. You will always be my American Family forever and I really love you two."*

God will be bringing more international students to the University of Indianapolis this Fall.
