ARIZONA | JUNE 14-21, 2014

LEADER Bob & Liz Stone, Rusty Spiars **MINISTRY** Flagstaff Mission/Navajo **TEAM SIZE** 40

PURPOSE Help the church in Arizona by volunteering to serve at the VBS camp for Navajo families.

COST \$375 + travel costs. (NOTE: \$100 for children 10 and under.)

CANADA | JUNE 15-22, 2014

LEADER Larry Bandy **MINISTRY** Moultons/Northern Canada Evangelical Mission **TEAM SIZE** 5

PURPOSE Help prepare Pine Ridge Camp for a new season of ministry to Native North American children by performing any or all of the following: light building maintenance, general campground cleanup, organization of supplies, baking activities, and delivering leaflets announcing camp dates.

COST \$800 (if submitted by Dec 1, 2013) / \$1,100 (after Dec 1, 2013)

CASPIAN | MARCH 28-APRIL 6, 2014

LEADER Gary Meeks **MINISTRY** Caspian Fire **TEAM SIZE** 15

PURPOSE Help the Caspian people learn conversational English and share the Hope.

COST \$1,700 (if submitted by Dec 1, 2013) / \$2,000 (after Dec 1, 2013)

EAST ASIA | APRIL 9-17, 2014

LEADER contact Ron Page **MINISTRY** Engaging with Students in this large East Asia country. **TEAM SIZE** 5

PURPOSE Assist several English-teaching believers as they work on college campuses. Experienced professionals will share their lives, knowledge, and skills through leadership development forums working with young college student leaders. Lectures and seminars will be given at multiple campus venues. Those not wanting to lecture are welcomed and will be greatly used during the trip.

COST \$3,000 (if submitted by Dec 1, 2013) / \$3,300 (after Dec 1, 2013)

HUNGARY | JULY 11-20, 2014

LEADER Bob Doster **MINISTRY** Word of Life - Hungary **TEAM SIZE** 16-25

PURPOSE Working with Word of Life to reach teens with the gospel and encourage their walk with Jesus. We will teach conversational English or coach sports such as basketball, flag football, and baseball—while sharing Jesus. There is also a need for help with maintenance and project improvements.

COST \$1,600 (if submitted by Dec 1, 2013) / \$1,900 (after Dec 1, 2013)

INDIA | NOVEMBER 13-24, 2014

LEADER Terry Sites **MINISTRY** Good News for India **TEAM SIZE** 10-15

PURPOSE Get a vision for the unreached in northern India and learn about the church planting, education, and orphan care ministries of our partner, Good News for India.

COST \$1,800 (if submitted by June 1, 2014) / \$2,100 (after June 1, 2014)

KENYA | OCTOBER 31- NOVEMBER 12, 2014

LEADER Darcy Weaver **MINISTRY** Nairobi Evangelical Graduate School of Theology **TEAM SIZE** 10-15

PURPOSE Visiting the NEGST campus and the vibrant ministries and churches of NEGST students – including an AIDS clinic, slum ministry, orphanage, and schools.

COST \$2,000 (if submitted by June 1, 2014) / \$2,300 (after June 1, 2014)

(NOTE: There is an additional cost associated with an optional Safari.)

UKRAINE TRIP 1 | MAY 2014

LEADER Debbie Sutton **MINISTRY** Ukrainian Evangelical Theological Seminary **TEAM SIZE** 3-5

PURPOSE Assist staff in managing the campus as a self-sustaining, well-functioning facility by sharing experience in hotel/hospitality management, food and restaurant management, event-planning, public relations, communications, and business.

COST \$1,900 (if submitted by Dec 1, 2013) / \$2,200 (after Dec 1, 2013)

UKRAINE TRIP 2 | SEPTEMBER 7-16, 2014

LEADER Debbie Sutton **MINISTRY** Ukrainian Evangelical Theological Seminary **TEAM SIZE** 3-5

PURPOSE Learn about the ministry of the seminary, encourage the staff and student body and represent Christ and College Park Church at the fall graduation.

COST \$1,900 (if submitted by June 1, 2014) / \$2,200 (after June 1, 2014)

GENERAL INFO

PRAYER | Prayer is the foundation of everything we do and our only confidence for success. Pray about your involvement and follow God's direction.

FINANCES | You are responsible for the costs of your trip. You are welcome to raise support, but we would encourage you to pay for at least a part of your trip from your own resources if you are able. We encourage you not to draw funds away from your regular church giving for your trip. **NOTE:** *All costs listed are estimates and are subject to change. The global outreach team will keep you updated, once you're signed up, if any prices change.*

TEAM PREPARATION | Your team will meet several times before departure: to pray, bond together, and learn about the country and ministry where you will be serving. These meetings are an essential part of the whole experience.

TRAINING SESSIONS | Attendance-required sessions will be staged for the purpose of helping Vision Trip participants fully prepare to serve.

DEBRIEFING | To help you process all that you've learned on the trip, you will have a debriefing meeting with your team upon return.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

1. If you plan to go on a 2014 Vision Trip, please mark your calendars to attend **mandatory training sessions:**

March 16 & 23, 2014 or

September 14 & 21, 2014.

This training is to help you become more mentally, spiritually & culturally prepared for your vision trip.

2. Application forms are available at the Global Outreach wall in the Atrium or online. Completed forms should be submitted to Ron Page, along with a non-refundable deposit of \$100 (per family), made payable to College Park Church by the deadline dates listed for each trip.

Please check your trip's deadline date above. After the deadline date, a place on the team is not assured.

3. You will be informed upon acceptance. Before your ticket is purchased, you will be asked to sign and return other forms, guaranteeing your participation.

4. Your team leader will contact you with dates for team meetings.

5. Make sure you have a passport that is valid for six months beyond your return date.
