#### **HOW TO PRAY**

Pray over the praises and requests of those around you but here are some additional ways to pray into our passage this week.

- Ask God to open your heart during REACH for how he wants you to be a part of reaching the unreached.
- Pray for our missionaries and partners.
- Ask God to give you a sense of urgency for lost people around you and around the world.
- Ask God to give you a heart for the nations, including people from other nations who live near you.
- Pray that God would raise up laborers for the harvest from within College Park Church.

# **APPLICATION AND DISCUSSION**

These questions focus on the sermon text and message.

- 1. Why should the return of Jesus push us towards personal evangelism and global outreach? What will happen to those who have not repented of sin and trusted in Christ?
- 2. What are some reasons we as Christians are lulled into living under the assumption that there's always more time? Why don't we have more urgency in global missions?
- 3. What responsibility do you have to help reach the unreached peoples of the world?
- 4. Have you been on a Vision Trip before? If so, discuss with your group what you experienced and learned.
- 5. What are ways you can be involved with and support our missionaries and global partnerships?
- 6. What are some of the barriers keeping you from being involved in personal evangelism locally and missions globally?
- 7. What are ways you can keep the unreached peoples in your mind and prayers throughout the year? Is this worth doing?
- 8. How do you respond when you hear news about all the troubles around the world?
